

Lanarkshire Local Medical Committee Limited

The GP Subcommittee has two main statutory functions:

- To provide advice on the operation of general medical services;
- To advise the Area Medical Committee. (The general function of the AMC is to advise the Health Board on the provision of NHS services.)

The Local Medical Committee deals with matters relating to the remuneration and conditions of service of doctors. These are generally referred to as medico-political.

In Lanarkshire, the two Committees are represented by the same office bearers and a single committee for both functions.

GP Sub Committee/Lanarkshire LMC Monthly Meetings

The monthly meeting consists of the GP Sub-Committee meeting which takes place first, this has members from NHS Lanarkshire taking part. After the GP Sub-Committee meeting these members leave the meeting and the LMC meeting takes place.
